#### Letter from the Vicar

'In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength.' These words from the prophet Isaiah might seem like the counsel of a madman or at least a dreamy idealist this December! We know all too well just how busy many of us can get in the run-up to Christmas and there are certainly things to be done and preparations to be made. On the other hand, there will be others who would love a bit more activity, but circumstances such as illness, stress or sorrow may prevent them from sharing in the busyness and festivity all around.

The Church of England this year has produced a little resource to encourage us to snatch a few quiet and thoughtful moments whatever our situation. It is appropriately entitled #God With Us (one of the central messages of Christmas) and the hashtag indicates you can get the material sent to your phone or e-mail inbox, but you can also get a hard copy (we have a few in church). The Archbishop of Canterbury writes in its introduction: 'My prayer is that this booklet helps you unwrap in your own life God's gifts of peace, hope and love. May your Christmas journey lead you closer not just to the heart of Christmas, but to the person

of Jesus whose birth we celebrate in this wonderful season.'

These are helpful sentiments for us in Pagham as this coming year we embark on a Year of Prayer. There will be various things going on through the church and even here in Good News, but the main thing is that any of us can do it. And when we pray there isn't a complicated formula, but simply allowing ourselves to be led to the heart of God, which is Jesus Christ. Returning, rest, quietness and trust are all good ingredients in this, so my prayer is that this Advent, this Christmas and in 2018, we can find rest and in that place, find also the God who is with us in Jesus Christ.
